Stories we want to tell through our tours	<p>The Kerama Islands are known for their beautiful beaches, and if you visit simply for sightseeing, the white beaches, blue sea, and marine sports are a wonderful sightseeing spot that leaves a lasting impression, but until just 30 to 40 years ago, there were not so many tourists visiting, and people's lives were much closer to nature than now.</p> <p>The sense of seasons according to the lunar calendar, awareness of the tides, daily utensils created from natural materials, traditional annual events, and food enjoyed in each season are just some of the attractive aspects.</p> <p>However, as the island has become a tourist destination, the number of immigrants has increased, and logistics have progressed, island life has also changed. Some people are attracted to a lifestyle that is close to nature and enjoy the value of learning from the elderly, and they are making efforts to pass on their skills and spirituality by interacting with the elderly on a daily basis.</p> <p>We hope that by interacting with these people through their travels, they will come into contact with the values and outlook on life that are typical of life on a remote island, and feel a change and positive impact on the distance between themselves and nature and the way they face it.</p>

The e-bike tour will take visitors on a tour of rice cultivation and farm work, giving them a sense of the down-to-earth lifestyle of the local people, despite the fact that the island is a tourist destination. During the tour, visitors can experience the traditional taste of Okinawan sweets (moochie) making and interact directly with the local people. You will notice the peaceful atmosphere and the slow flow of time, and feel the difference from the city.</div>

The story of the revival of the technique, which was once a typical Okinawan export, but gradually fell into disuse and the number of people who could make it seemed to disappear, tells us a lot about the days when nature and daily life were close to each other. Here, we are reminded once again of the distance between ourselves and nature, as we learn about the production of beautiful hats and crafts from plants found in nature, and how we live without placing a burden on nature.</div>
